

## Notice

This is to bring to your notice that Post Matric Scholarship for SC, OBC and Economically backward class for the year 2021-2022 is open. All those who wish to apply kindly go through the website [www.scholarships.punjab.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.punjab.gov.in).

**Eligibility criteria to apply for scholarship is as follows:**

- Income declaration of self-employed parents/guardian should be in the form a certificate issued by Revenue officer not below the rank of Tehsildar, Employed parents/guardians are required to obtain income certificate from their employer. Employed parents/guardians should obtain consolidated certificate from Revenue Officer for any other additional source of income.
- Scholarships will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- Only those candidates who belong to scheduled Castes so specified in relation to the State/UT and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible
- Candidates who, after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in a different subject e.g. Intermediate Science after Intermediate Arts or B.Com after B.A. or M.A in one subject after M.A in other subjects will not be eligible.
- A scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend.
- Aadhaar linked Bank accounts to Facilitate payments through the Aadhaar Payment Bridge.
- Annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.
- Students should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the institutions.

# NOTICE

Interested Students who belong to minority category can apply for Scholarship under the scheme of "Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities". Eligibility criteria to apply for scholarship is as follows::

- Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992
- Scholarships will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- Annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.
- An Income Certificate, issued from Competent Authority in the State/UT Governments is required in respect of parent/guardian of the students.
- A Self-Certified Community Certificate is required from the students who has attained 18 years of age.
- Students should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the institutions.
