



## NOTICE

Interested students who belong to minority category can apply for Scholarship under the scheme of “**Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities**” on National Scholarship Portal ([www.scholarships.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.gov.in)). Eligibility criteria to apply for scholarship is as follows:

- Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Persis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2(c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992.
- Scholarships will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalents grade in the previous final examination.
- Annual income of whose Parents/Guardians from all sources does not exceed **Rs.2.50 Lakh**.
- An Income Certificate, issued from Competent Authority in the State/UT Governments is required in respect of Parents/Guardian of the students.
- A Self-Certified Community Certificate is required from the students who has attained **18** years of age.
- Students should be regular in attendance for which the yardsticks will be decided by the competent authority of the institutions.
